The Missouri Ethics Commission, considered at the November 19, 2010 meeting, the complaint filed against you. The Commission reviewed the allegations of failure to file an April Quarterly report pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo.

From the facts presented, the Commission voted to dismiss this case. An April 2010 Quarterly Disclosure Report has been filed for the four-day period of March 26 to March 31, 2010. The expenditure which was technically required to be filed on this report was in fact reported on the 30 Day After Election Report on May 26, 2010. The Committee originally reported all contributions and expenditures which occurred during that election period, and the investigation did not show that the committee failed to report any contributions and expenditures. The Commission reminds you to file all required campaign finance disclosure reports, with all required contributions and expenditure for that reporting period.
