Dear Mr. Harmon:

The Missouri Ethics Commission, considered at the June 21, 2013 meeting, the complaint filed against you and Missourians Against Unfair Taxes. The Commission reviewed the allegation of failure to file an 8 Day Before Election Report, pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo. The complaint included a campaign mailer circulated and opposing a candidate for the City of O'Fallon Council Ward 5, prior to the April 2, 2013 election.

From the facts presented, the Commission voted to dismiss this case. Evidence showed that the expenditures for the campaign mailer were not incurred or paid for during the 8 Day Before Election reporting period. The expenditure was timely reported on the 30 Day After Election report, although the committee has failed to file a direct expenditure report detailing the expenditure.

The Commission reminds you to follow all campaign finance reporting laws pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo, including amending your 30 Day After the General Election Report to include a direct expenditure report detailing the expenditure.
