Dear Senator Nieves:

The Missouri Ethics Commission considered, at February 4, 2011 meeting, the complaint filed against you and Citizens for Nieves. The Commission reviewed the allegation of violating Section 130.041, RSMo., on the April, July and October 2009 Quarterly disclosure reports by failing to report:

- ✓ Aggregates for each contribution received
- ✓ Address and employer information for each contribution received *and*
- ✓ Required consultant services information

The Commission found reasonable grounds that reporting violations occurred pursuant to Section 130.041, RSMo., for failing to report aggregates, address and employer information, and required consultant services information. Upon receipt of the complaint filed with the Commission, the committee filed corrected and amended reports. From the facts presented, the Commission voted to dismiss this case at this time.

The Commission reminds you of your responsibility in complying with the reporting requirements established in Chapter 130, RSMo. You must ensure the law's requirements are followed for each filed campaign finance report. Specifically, Section 130.041, RSMo., requires reporting:

- ✓ Aggregates for each contribution received
- ✓ Address and employer information for each contribution received *and*
- ✓ Specific details of consultant services
