The Missouri Ethics Commission, considered at the December 13, 2013 meeting, the complaint filed against you and Citizens for Fairness. The Commission reviewed the allegation of failure to timely file a statement of committee organization, pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo.

From the facts presented, the Commission voted to dismiss this case. Documentation and interviews show that the committee timely formed, filed and reported with the appropriate election authority prior to incurring or paying expenditures. Citizens for Fairness formed as a campaign committee to oppose a local ballot measure in Jackson County Missouri. The Committee timely filed with the Jackson County Board of Elections, and with the Missouri Ethics Commission upon receiving a contribution in excess of \$5,000.00.
