The Missouri Ethics Commission considered the complaint filed against you in your capacity as treasurer for Melissa Robinson, candidate for Kansas City School Board during the April 8, 2014 election, at its July 7, 2014 meeting.

The Commission reviewed the allegation that campaign finance reports filed by the Committee to Elect Melissa Robinson failed to report in-kind contributions made to the committee.

The Commission took no action on this complaint because there were not four affirmative votes to dismiss the complaint nor were there four affirmative votes to refer the complaint to Commission counsel. Section 105.955.6, RSMo, requires any action of the Commission have four affirmative votes. As a result, the Commission is taking no further action on this complaint at this time.
