Dear Mr. Chabot:

The Missouri Ethics Commission considered the complaint filed against you and the Ferguson-Florissant School District at its August 14, 2014 meeting. The Commission reviewed the allegation the district expended public funds to support a ballot measure in violation of section 115.646, RSMo, and failed to include a paid for by disclosure as required by Section 130.031.8, RSMo, when a school marquee displayed a message supporting a ballot measure for the August 5, 2014 election.

From the facts presented, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint filed against you and Ferguson-Florissant School District. The Commission found no evidence that the school board or its superintendent authorized or knew about the message.
