Dear Mr. Landwehr:

The Missouri Ethics Commission considered the complaints filed against you at its August 14, 2014 meeting. The Commission reviewed the allegation that you were a member of "The Gerald Committee" whose name appeared in a paid for by disclosure on campaign literature related to Edward Adams candidacy for the Board of Aldermen. The complaint further alleges that the campaign literature failed to include a proper paid for by disclosure pursuant to Section 130.031.8, RSMo.

The Commission also reviewed the allegation that you violated local ordinance by participating in a local election while employed as Public Works Director for the City of Gerald. The Commission reviewed the ordinances and did not identify an ordinance that prohibits the conduct alleged.

From the facts presented, the Commission found no reasonable grounds to support a violation of Section 130.031.8, RSMo, and dismissed the complaint.
