Dear Mr. Corrigan:

The Missouri Ethics Commission, considered at the April 28, 2010 meeting, the complaint filed against Corrigan for County Executive. The Commission reviewed the allegation of failing to report a contribution from a single contributor in excess of \$5,000 within 48 hours of receipt. The Commission did not find reasonable grounds to believe a violation of Chapter 130 occurred.

The investigation showed that the contribution in question was incorrectly reported on the January 2010 Quarterly Report. While the contribution was reported as \$10,000.00 received on November 2, 2009 from one individual, the contribution was actually received from two individuals. Each contribution did not reach the threshold of Section 130.044.1, RSMo which requires contributions in excess of \$5,000.00 to be reported within 48 hours of receiving the contribution. On January 26, 2010, an amended January 2010 report was filed and the investigation of the contribution supported the amendment.

From the facts presented, the Commission voted to dismiss this case as the allegation was unsubstantiated. The investigation did not show reasonable grounds for a violation of Chapter 130, RSMo.
