

EXHIBIT A

law, the undersigned Respondents knowingly and voluntarily waive each and every one of these rights and freely enter into this Joint Stipulation of Facts, Waiver of Hearings before the Missouri Ethics Commission, and Consent Order with Joint Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and agree to abide by the terms of this document.

I.

Based upon the foregoing, the Petitioner and the undersigned Respondents jointly stipulate to the following and request that the Missouri Ethics Commission adopt as its own the Joint Proposed Findings of Fact and the Joint Proposed Conclusions of Law, as follows:

JOINT FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Missouri Ethics Commission (“the Commission”) is an agency of the State of Missouri established pursuant to § 105.955, RSMo, in part for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of Chapter 130, RSMo.
2. Respondent MO National Education Assoc-PAC (“Committee”) is a continuing committee which was in existence at all relevant times.
3. Respondent DeeAnn Aull is the treasurer of the Committee and was therefore responsible for all reporting requirements for the Committee pursuant to §130.058 RSMo.
4. Respondents published, circulated, and distributed printed matter constituting a flier supporting two school board candidates in Park Hill, Missouri in the April 6, 2010 election

5. The flyer stated Paid for by Missouri NEA PAC, DeeAnn Aull, Treasurer. A true and correct copy of the flyer is marked as Exhibit A, attached hereto, and incorporated herein by reference.

6. The proper name of the Committee as recorded on the Statement of Committee Organization is "MO National Education Assoc-PAC."

7. The correct identification of the sponsor was "MO National Education Assoc-PAC, DeeAnn Aull, Treasurer" and not "Missouri NEA PAC."

8. On April 28, 2010, a complaint was filed with Petitioner alleging campaign finance violations against Respondents.

9. Pursuant to § 105.961.1, RSMo, a special investigator has conducted an investigation and reported findings to the Commission.

JOINT CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. §130.031.8 RSMo states:

Any person publishing, circulating, or distributing any printed matter relative to any candidate for public office or any ballot measure shall on the face of the printed matter identify in a clear and conspicuous manner the person who paid for the printed matter with the words "Paid for by" followed by the proper identification of the sponsor pursuant to this section.

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2) In regard to any printed matter paid for by a committee, it shall be sufficient identification to print the name of the committee as required to be registered by subsection 5 of section 130.021 and the name and title of the committee treasurer who was serving when the printed matter was paid for.

2. §130.011 (22), RSMo defines a "Person" as "an individual, group of individuals... committee ... political party or any executive committee thereof... "

3. There is probable cause to believe that Respondents violated §130.031.8, RSMo by failing to properly identify the name of the committee on printed matter relating to candidates in the April 6, 2010 election.

II.

Based on the foregoing, the parties hereto mutually agree and stipulate that the following shall constitute the order entered by the Missouri Ethics Commission in this matter. This order will be effective immediately upon the issuance of the Consent Order of the Missouri Ethics Commission without further action by any party.

1. The parties to this Joint Stipulation understand that the Petitioner will maintain this Joint Stipulation as an open and public record of the Missouri Ethics Commission.

2. The Commission shall issue its Consent Order in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

a. Respondents agree that they will comply with all relevant sections of Chapter 130, RSMo.

b. It is the order of the Missouri Ethics Commission that a fee is imposed against the Respondents DeeAnn Aull and MO National Education Assoc-PAC in the amount of \$100.00 pursuant to §105.961.4(6) RSMo. The fee will be paid by check or money order made payable to the Missouri Ethics Commission and sent to the Missouri Ethics Commission, and will be due at the time of execution of this Joint Stipulation.

3. The parties consent to the entry of record and approval of this Joint Stipulation and to the termination of any further proceedings before the Commission based upon the Complaint filed by the Petitioner in the above action.

4. Respondents, together with their heirs, successors and assigns, do hereby waive, release, acquit and forever discharge the Missouri Ethics Commission and its attorney of or from any liability, claim, actions, causes of action, fees, costs and expenses, and compensation, including, but not limited to, a claim for attorney's fees whatsoever which Respondents and their attorney now have or which they may hereafter have, which is based upon or arises out of the above case.
