Dear Mr. Dooley:

The Missouri Ethics Commission, considered at the October 1, 2010 meeting, the complaint filed against you. The Commission reviewed the allegations of failure to file 24 Hour Notices pursuant to Chapter 130, RSMo.

From the facts presented, the Commission voted to dismiss this case as the allegation is unsubstantiated. The investigation did not show reasonable grounds for a violation of Chapter 130, RSMo. The complaint alleged that contributions which were reported on the 30 Day After Election Report should have been reported on 24 Hour Contribution Notices prior to the Primary Election. The investigation showed the contributions at issue were received by the campaign on August 16, 2010, and the contribution dates were incorrectly reported on the original 30 Day After Report. That report has since been amended to state the correct date that contributions were received. There was no violation for failure to report contributions on 24 Hour Notice prior to the election.
