Dear Representative English:

The Missouri Ethics Commission considered the complaint filed you and Citizens for Keith English at its October 27, 2014 meeting. The complaint alleges that you failed to report receipt of a contribution reported by another committee, misreported expenditures as contributions to committees, inaccurately reported the addresses on reported lobbyist reimbursements and failed to amend summary sheet totals from the 2012 election to start a new election cycle.

From the facts presented, the Commission finds no reasonable grounds exist to support a violation of Chapter 130, RSMo, and is dismissing the complaint. The Commission concluded your explanations for the reporting errors were reasonable and promptly rectified when you were notified of the reporting errors. To the extent the reporting errors failed to disclose certain information, such as address information, those errors did not impact the public's ability to know how your committee expended funds.

Finally, there was no failure by you or your committee to report a contribution because the committee did not deposit the check and in good faith returned the check, within the timelines set out in Section 130.036.2, RSMo, to the committee that wrote the check.
