Dear Mr. Radabaugh:

The Missouri Ethics Commission considered the complaint filed against you at its December 12, 2014 meeting. The complaint alleges that you while serving as Sheridan Township Trustee received financial gain in violation of Section 105.454, RSMo, when you hired yourself to haul rock for the township.

The Commission finds no reasonable grounds exist to support a violation of Chapter 105, RSMo, and is dismissing the complaint. You do not submit bids nor do you have any ownership interest in the quarries submitting bids to the county. You haul rock and are paid as an independent contractor by Trager Limestone who has been awarded a county bid.

The Complaint further alleges a conflict of interest in serving as a trustee of the township while your wife served as township clerk. As your wife has not served as township clerk in over two years, the Commission is not authorized to investigate this allegation under section 105.757.3, RSMo.
