Dear Representative Redmon:

The Missouri Ethics Commission considered the complaint filed against you at its August 7, 2015 meeting. The complaint alleged that you violated Chapter 105, RSMo, by consenting to lobbyist expenditures being reported to you when the lobbyist expenditures were actually made on behalf of other legislators. The complaint cited a statement attributed to you in a May 9, 2015 article in the Kirksville Daily Express.

The Commission reviewed lobbyist expenditure reports from 2013, 2014 and 2015 and found no evidence of inaccuracies. Nor did the Commission find that the expenditures should have been reported on behalf of other public officials.

From the facts presented, the Commission finds no reasonable grounds exist to support a violation of Chapter 130, RSMo, and is dismissing the complaint.
