Dear Ms. Gass:

The Missouri Ethics Commission considered the complaint filed against you at its September 3, 2015 meeting. The complaint alleged that you, while serving as a village trustee, violated the conflict of interest laws when you authorized repairs resulting from storm damage to village streets including the street where you reside. The complaint alleged that the work performed on your street was superior to the work performed on other streets.

The Commission determined that the work performed on all village streets was performed pursuant to a grant awarded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and approved by the board of trustees.

From the facts presented, the Commission finds no reasonable grounds exist to support a conflict of interest violation of Chapter 105, RSMo, and is dismissing the complaint.
