The Missouri Ethics Commission, at its January 23, 1996 meeting, discussed your request for an opinion. From the facts presented in your letter, the Missouri Ethics Commission concluded that it would be a conflict of interest for you to be Public Administrator of Osage County and secretary to the Prosecuting Attorney of Osage County. The Commission directs your attention to section 105.454 RSMo.
