At the June 1, 1996 meeting of the Missouri Ethics Commission, your request for an opinion was discussed. The following is in response to your question: *May I serve on a committee known as "The Aging Federation" while also being employed as the Director of the Missouri Kidney Program and also serving as a member of the Governor's Advisory Council on Aging?*

From the facts presented in your letter, the Commission stated there appears to be no violation of the conflict of interest section of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. The Commission further suggested that you should check with your employer to determine whether or not your employer has specific rules or regulations concerning the involvement of employees and political activities.
