At the January 21, 1997 meeting of the Missouri Ethics Commission, the Commission discussed your request your opinion. The following is the Commission's response to your question:

Would it be a conflict for a superintendent of schools to also serve on the community board of the Citizens National Bank, which is not currently the district's official depository, but could bid for future business?

The Commission stated that it is their opinion that there is no conflict of interest in serving on the community board of the bank and being superintendent of schools. The Commission suggests that you become familiar with sections 105.452 and 105.454, RSMo dealing with conflicts of interest.
