
At the January 21, 1997 meeting of the Missouri Ethics Commission, your request for an opinion was discussed. The following is the Commission's response to your question:

*Must members of the State Historical Records Advisory Board file Personal Financial Disclosure Statements?*

From the information presented in your letter, the Commission has determined that the members of the State Historical Records Advisory Board serve only in an advisory capacity and have not been designated as decision-making public servants and therefore do not have to file Personal Financial Disclosure Statements. However, the Commission advises that it is the ongoing responsibility of the agency to determine whether or not these individuals meet the statutory requirements to qualify as decision-making public servants and are required to file.
