

At the April 20, 1999 meeting of the Missouri Ethics Commission, your request for an opinion was discussed. The following is the Commission's response to your question:

Would my position as House Banking Committee chairman prohibit me from receiving payment for my services with a Fortune 500 Company?

From the information presented, the Commission finds there is no conflict of interest as set out in sections 105.452 or 105.456, RSMo. You are reminded that if a situation should arise where you have a substantial personal or private interest in a bill, you must file a written report of the nature of the interest with the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives. This is contained in section 105.461, RSMo.
