At the September 22, 2000 meeting of the Missouri Ethics Commission, your request for an opinion was discussed. The following is the Commission's response to your question:

As an independent insurance agent, may I continue to provide insurance coverage for the county in which I am a district commissioner?

The Commission stated that you may still sell insurance to the county provided that the sale is made after public notice and competitive bidding. The bid received must be the lowest. You cannot use confidential information in preparation of your bid. Please also be aware of sections 105.452 and 105.454, RSMo.
