At the May 23, 2002 meeting of the Missouri Ethics Commission, your request for an opinion was discussed. The following is the Commission's response to your question:

Can I continue my secondary employment as a volunteer at the Family Advocacy Center, while also being employed by the Division of Family Services?

From the facts presented, it is the Commission's opinion that your secondary employment with the Family Advocacy Center does not violate the conflict of interest laws as contained in section 105.452, RSMo.

The Commission has statutory authority to issue opinions concerning potential conflicts of interest governed by sections 105.450 through 105.467, RSMo. However, the Commission cannot opine on whether an employee's conduct may violate the employer's internal rules and policies. Therefore, to the extent your opinion request asks for guidance regarding whether your conduct violates the Division of Family Services policies involving outside employment, the Commission does not opine. That determination must be made by your agency.
