## Aug 7, 2012 Primary Election

### Personal Financial Disclosure

- Due 04/10/12
- After 04/10/12 - late fees at \$10/day
- After 04/17/12 - late fee, disqualification & removal from ballot

### Committees

- PAC form by 06/08/12
- Other committees form by 07/09/12  
(Deadline is next business day due to 07/08/12, falling on a weekend)

### April Quarterly

(Due if committee formed before 03/31/12)

- Close 03/31/12
- Due 04/16/12 (Deadline is next business day due to 04/15/12, falling on a weekend)

### 40 Day Before

- Not Required

### July Quarterly

- Close 06/30/12
- Due 07/16/12 (Deadline is next business day due to 07/15/12, falling on a weekend)

### 8 Day Before

- Close 07/26/12
- Due 07/30/12

### ★ 08/07/12 Election Date

### 30 Day After

- Close 09/01/12
- Due 09/06/12

## Nov 6, 2012 General Election

### Personal Financial Disclosure

(only for jurisdictions authorized to elect directors in Nov., such as 911 & emergency service directors)

- Due 09/04/12
- After 09/04/12 - late fees at \$10/day
- After 09/11/12 - late fee, disqualification & removal from ballot

*A candidate required to file a PFD because of their candidacy in a primary election is required to amend their PFD by the close of business on the Monday before the general election if they obtain any additional financial interests or have any change in their existing financial interests since the filing of their last PFD. See [PFD FAQs](#) for more. (§105.487(1))*

### Committees

- PAC form by 09/07/12
- Other committees form by 10/08/12  
(Deadline is next business day due to 10/07/12, falling on a weekend)

### 40 Day Before

- Not Required

### October Quarterly

- Close 09/30/12
- Due 10/15/12

### 8 Day Before

- Close 10/25/12
- Due 10/29/12

### ★ 11/06/12 Election Date

### 30 Day After

- Close 12/01/12
- Due 12/06/12

NOTE: 40 Day Before report only req'd if accepted contributions or made expenditures for that election.  
8 Day Before, & 30 Day After reports only required if made contributions or expenditures for that election.

# Upcoming Filing Deadlines & Reminders

## Additional Information

### 48 Hour Report of Contribution over \$5,000 (File as needed)

- Any individual or committee receiving any contribution (including loans, see §130.011(11) RSMo. for full definition of contribution) from any single contributor **over \$5,000** must electronically report same to the Missouri Ethics Commission within **48 hours** of its receipt (must also report this contribution in the committee's next filed report).

### Late Contribution Report (File as needed)

- Any receipt of a contribution (including loans, see §130.011(11) RSMo. for full definition of contribution) **over \$250** that is received between the 11<sup>th</sup> day through the day before the election, must be reported within **24 hours** of its receipt (must also report this contribution in the committee's next filed report). The disclosure may be made by electronically or by any written means of communication.

### PACS – Late Expenditure Report (File as needed)

- Each time a **political action committee spends more than \$250**, whether in a single expenditure or in combined expenditures, after the 12<sup>th</sup> day before an election, a full disclosure report must be filed within **24 hours**. This does not include contributions made to another committee.

#### Due Dates & Deadlines for filing:

- **Electronic Filers:**
  - Electronic reports must be filed by 5:00 p.m. on the due date.
- **Paper Filers (Local Campaign Finance, & PFD)**
  - Mailed reports must be post-marked, prior to their due date
  - Hand delivered reports must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the due date
