

Final Action: MEC No. 20-0099-I, Christopher Morrison

Date: February 18, 2021

The Missouri Ethics Commission took final consideration of the complaint filed against Six County PAC, Harvey Faircloth, and Christopher Morrison at its February 11, 2021 meeting.

The complaint filed with the Commission alleged that this PAC failed to properly report expenditures by providing a description of the services and whether the expenditures supported or opposed candidates or ballot measures. Harvey Faircloth is the PAC's treasurer and Christopher Morrison is identified as an officer.

The MEC investigation supported Complainant's allegation against Six County PAC and treasurer Harvey Faircloth. They have since amended their campaign finance reports to include a Direct Expenditure Report. Six County PAC and Mr. Faircloth have resolved this violation by executing a Joint Stipulation of Facts, Waiver of Hearing before the Missouri Ethics Commission, and Consent Order with Joint Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. From the facts presented, the Commission found no reasonable grounds exist to support a violation of the Chapter 130, RSMo, against Christopher Morrison, and dismissed this individual from the complaint.
