

Final Action: MEC No. 20-0085-I, Joseph Wilson

The Missouri Ethics Commission took final consideration of the complaint filed against Civil PAC, Linda Primer and Joseph Wilson at its March 25, 2021 meeting.

The complaint filed with the Commission alleged that these Respondents distributed a campaign mailer prior to the August 2020 primary election but failed to disclose on the campaign finance reports that the expenditure opposed a particular candidate.

The MEC investigation determined that Joseph Wilson was not responsible for the reporting of the direct expenditures alleged in the legal complaint. Civil PAC and Linda Primer have resolved the violation by executing a Joint Stipulation of Facts, Waiver of Hearing before the Missouri Ethics Commission, and Consent Order with Joint Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. From the facts presented, the Commission found no reasonable grounds exist to support a violation of the Chapter 130, RSMo against Respondent Joseph Wilson, and dismissed this individual from the complaint.
