

Commission Action: MEC No. 24-0023-I: Judi Colter, Mountain View, Missouri

The Missouri Ethics Commission received a complaint on March 15, 2024 against Judi Colter, alleging violations of the campaign finance law. Because Judi Colter was a candidate in the April 2, 2024, municipal election, Missouri statutes required that an investigation be completed within 15 business days and presented to the Commission for a determination of whether there are reasonable grounds of a violation or whether it should be dismissed. Section 130.054, RSMo.

Missouri statute, Section 105.955.6, RSMo requires at least four commission members are necessary for a quorum, and at least four affirmative votes shall be required for any action or recommendation of the Commission. Commissioners whose terms expired on March 15, 2024, cannot serve on unexpired terms. Because the Commission does not currently have a quorum of four Commissioners to consider the complaint, the Commission could not take into consideration an investigation report.

Because there were not four Commissioners able to consider the investigation within the 15-Day timeframe, the Commission could take no action on this complaint.
