Final Action: MEC No. 24-0075-I: William Eigel and Eigel for Missouri

Date: December 1, 2025

The Missouri Ethics Commission took final consideration of the complaint filed against William Eigel and Eigel for Missouri at its December 1, 2025, meeting.

The Commission received a complaint alleging Mr. Eigel failed to report an in-kind contribution received from the owner of a digital billboard after an advertisement was displayed in support of Mr. Eigel's candidacy.

Based on the investigation, it was determined that Mr. Eigel was not aware of any expenditures made for the billboard in question. A group of supporters had assembled, approached the billboard owner, and paid for the advertisement in support of Mr. Eigel. It was also confirmed that Mr. Eigel did not have knowledge of the sign.

From the facts presented, the Commission finds no reasonable grounds exist to support a violation of Chapter 130, RSMo., and dismissed the complaint.
