Final Action: MEC No. 26-0014-I Derrick Good, President of Jefferson County Port Authority

Date May 14, 2026

The Missouri Ethics Commission took final consideration of the complaint filed against Derrick Good, President of the Jefferson County Port Authority at its May 14, 2026, meeting.

The complaint alleged that Mr. Good used his official position to benefit his private law firm; that he used confidential information obtained through his role as President of the Jefferson County Port Authority; that he disclosed such confidential information; and that he acted in his official capacity to secure a special monetary benefit or financial gain for himself or his employer.

The investigation confirmed that Mr. Good is a partner at a law firm that represents an entity that could potentially appear before the Jefferson County Port Authority for approval of a development project.

However, although Mr. Good is both a law firm partner and a voting member of the Port Authority, the investigation found no evidence that he used his official position to obtain financial gain for himself or his firm. The investigation further found no evidence that Mr. Good disclosed confidential information for his own benefit or for the benefit of any third party.

Based on the facts presented, the Commission finds no reasonable grounds to believe that one or more violations of Chapter 105, RSMo, occurred, and therefore dismisses the complaint.
