## **Final Action: MEC No. 26-0023-I: Steve Koskela – Council Member Ward 3 of O’Fallon**

**Date June 3, 2026**

The Missouri Ethics Commission took final consideration of the complaint filed against Steve Koskela – Council Member Ward 3 of O’Fallon at its June 3, 2026, meeting.

An investigation reviewed allegations that Councilman Steve Koskela approved building permits that financially benefited his private employer and shared confidential city information with that employer. The investigation confirmed his official roles with the City of O’Fallon and his position as Vice President of Installed Sales at C Bennett Premium Building Supplies. It found no evidence that he used his position to financially benefit himself or his employer, nor that he disclosed confidential information for such purposes.

Based on the facts presented, the Commission finds no reasonable grounds to believe that one or more violations of Chapter 105, RSMo, occurred, and therefore dismisses the complaint.
