Dear Committee Treasurer:

Campaign finance committees with a dual filing requirement for campaign finance reports have an opportunity to eliminate filing their report with the local election authority *if the local election authority has signed an agreement with the Commission to waive the local filing requirement, and if your committee signs the enclosed agreement to file all future campaign finance reports only in the Commission's electronic format.*

The Missouri Association of County Clerks and Election Authorities adopted the following resolution at their annual meeting in September 2003.

Now therefore be it resolved, that the Missouri Association of County Clerks and Election Authorities encourages the Missouri Ethics Commission to maintain a free voluntary electronic filing program whereby those local election authorities who choose to participate will be relieved of the obligation to maintain a paper copy report of certain campaign finance committees obligated to file copies of reports with both the local election authority and with the Missouri Ethics Commission, provided the campaign finance committee signs an agreement to file all future campaign finance reports with the Missouri Ethics Commission in the Commission's approved electronic format.

Note – All county clerks and election authorities, except the St Louis City Board of Election Commissioners, have agreed to waive the dual filing requirement for campaign finance committees in their jurisdiction provided the committee signs an agreement with the Commission to file all future campaign finance reports only in the Commission's approved electronic format.

If the local election authority with whom your committee is required to file has agreed, you may take advantage of this opportunity for your committee by completing the enclosed agreement and return a signed, dated copy to the Commission.

If your committee has not already obtained a confidential PIN number to file reports, complete the enclosed Personal Identification Number Application form and return it with your signed agreement. Upon receipt of your PIN application a password will be emailed to you. Please ensure that all matters of mutual interest,
