

At the June 3, 1994 meeting of the Missouri Ethics Commission, I shared your letter dated May 19, 1994 and discussed your interpretation of the lobbyist reporting requirements contained in section 105.470 RSMo. The Commission believes that statute requires each lobbyist to report the name and address of each lobbyist principal by whom he is employed or in whose interest he appears or works. The Commission will not change their opinion previously expressed and will continue to require each lobbyist to inform the Commission of their principal; that principal being the person by whom he is employed or in whose interest he appears or works.

The Commission instructed me to convey their thanks to Mr. _____ for his abiding by the interpretation of the law while disagreeing with it. The Commission also appreciates your input and your candor and thanks you for your letter.
